


# Neat Fit Blinds

## Fitting & Operating Instructions

*Please follow the instructions carefully to install your blind correctly*


### 1. Install the top rail (left side)

- A) Holding the top and middle rail, position the top left tab of your blind in the corner of the window.
- B) Slide the tab under the rubber gasket. The tab should fit between the rubber gasket and the glazing.




### 2. Install the top rail (right side)

- A) Holding your blind at an angle, slide the top right tab under the rubber gasket of your window.
- B) Slide the blind in an upwards direction behind the rubber gasket.
- C) Slot the blind into a horizontal position at the top of the window.



### 3. Install the bottom rail

- A) Insert the bottom left tab behind the rubber gasket.
- B) Holding the bottom bar at an angle slide the bottom right tab under the rubber gasket of your window.
- C) Slide the blind in a downwards direction behind the rubber gasket.
- D) Slot the bottom rail into the final horizontal position.




## 5. Operating your blind

Your blinds will arrive pre-tensioned and ready for use.

A) Use the handle on the mid-rail to raise and lower the blind.

B) If you have purchased the Venetian blind option, open and close the slats by rotating the tilt wand.

## 6. Mis-Measured Blinds

If you have measured your blinds too narrow for your window, please find the plastic spacers provided with your blind and follow the instructions below.


A) Remove the end cap.

B) Insert the spacer.

C) Refit the end cap with spacer to the headrail.

### Trouble Shooting

#### Installing your blind

If you are struggling to insert your blinds into the rubber gasket of your UPVC windows, apply some common household surface polish to the gasket and gently ease the blind into position.

### WARNING

According to EN 13120

- Young children can be strangled by loops in pull cords, chains, tapes and inner cords that operate the product. They can also wrap cords around their necks.
- To avoid strangulation and entanglement, keep cords out of reach of young children.
- Move beds, cots and furniture away from window covering cords.
- Do not tie cords together. Make sure cords do not twist and create a loop.
- Install and use the included safety devices according to the installation instructions on these devices to reduce possibility of such an accident.
