


Fitting

1. Brackets will top fix into a lintel or face fix into a frame or wall. Ensure the tab of the bracket is positioned at the back.
2. Offer the blind up to the brackets and ensure you have equal coverage of the fabric over the frame or recess before fixing into the brackets. Valance should face into the room.
3. Tilt the front of the cassette forward and then hook the cassette (second channel in from the valance) into the front of the bracket.
4. Push the headrail cassette upwards and ensure the back of the cassette is locked into the bracket, you should hear a click. If fitting as face fix follow the same procedure.
5. After installation the retention clip must be removed. To remove, simply pull the clip downwards.




Hook the headrail cassette into the bracket

Control Chain

Refer to the separate Child Safety section under 'Health and Safety' for full information on child safety, including instructions on how to fit child safety devices and limitations around chain and cord lengths.

To ensure compliance with child safety legislation, a safety hook must be fitted to an adjacent wall for all Rollers with a continuous chain loop to keep the chain and cord taut and out of reach of children.



Safety Hook

Before leaving:

- It is a good idea to ensure the blind works correctly and the customer is made aware of how it operates.
- Fit all blinds with loops or cords with the relevant child safety device to ensure they meet child safety legislation. Refer to the separate Child Safety section under 'Health and Safety' for full information on child safety.
- Leave the 'Fitting & using Child Safety Devices' leaflet with the customer.
- Obtain a customer signature on the remittance section of the invoice confirming that the products and any applicable child safety devices have been fitted to the customer's satisfaction, that the child safety features of the product have been explained and demonstrated to them and that they have been given written instructions relating to fitting and using child safety devices.
